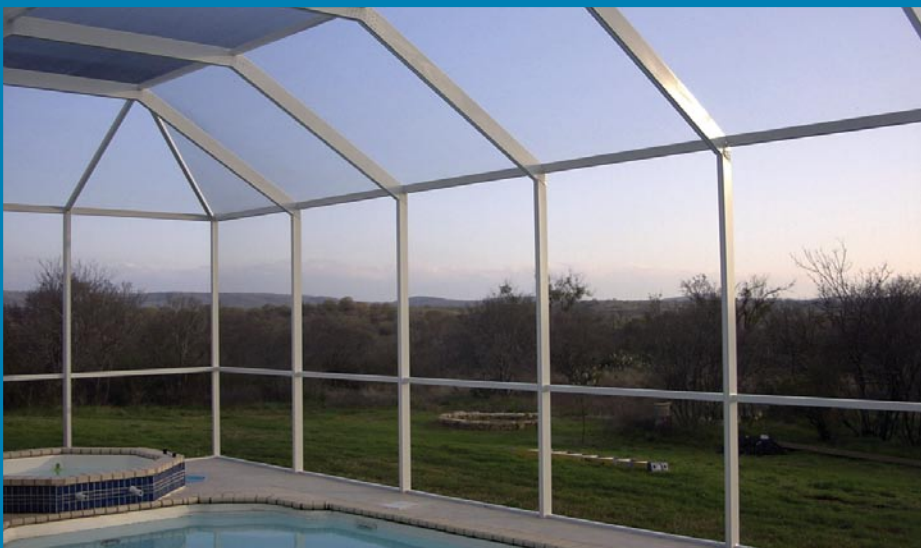

Protection from Insects and Debris.

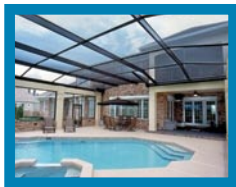

Its baked enamel finish resists scratches, weathering and chemical deterioration. The mesh of the screen is made of heavier than standard screen material to withstand outside weather conditions. Additional screen options are available to suit your specific needs.

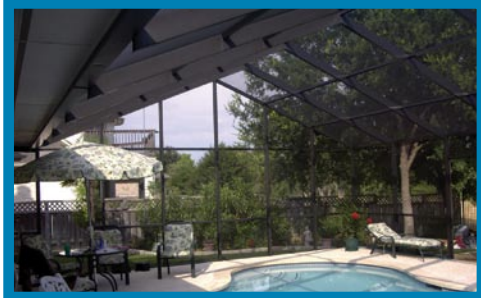


Top: Gable Roof pool cages provide height, strength, and beauty.

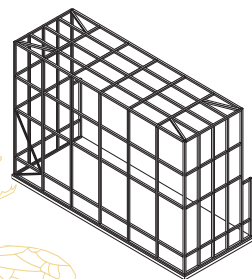
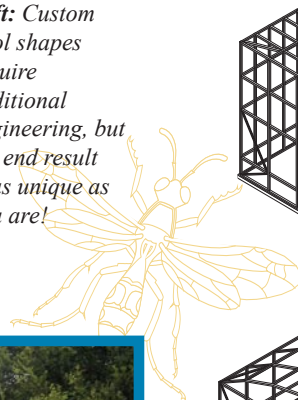
Right: A view of the inside Gable Roof pool cage pictured above.



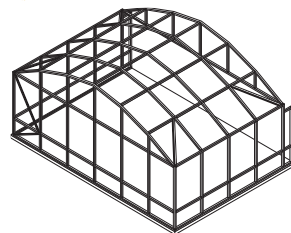

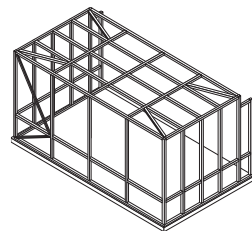
Right: Expansive, tall spaces can be engineered to provide an open feeling as demonstrated in this modified Mansard Roof pool cage.



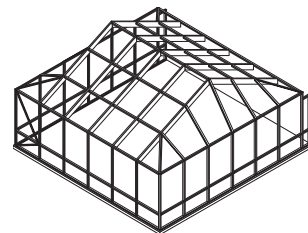
Two Story Flat Roof



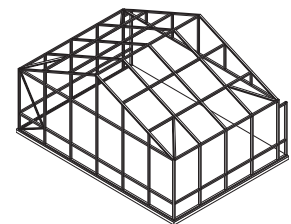
Dome Roof



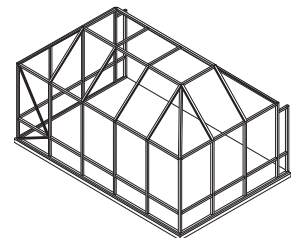
Flat Roof

Mansard Roof

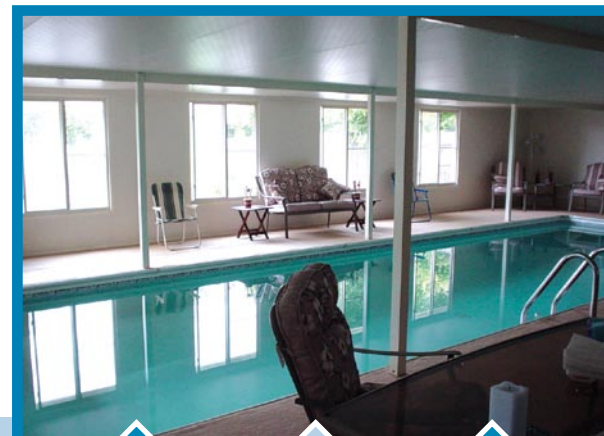
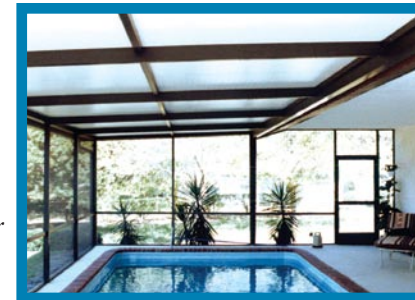
Right: The finish of the Snap-N-Lock™ panel creates a very clean, beautiful look for a pool room. The paint finish reflects light and helps brighten the entire space.

Right: Snap-N-Lock™ Panels were installed above where screen once was.

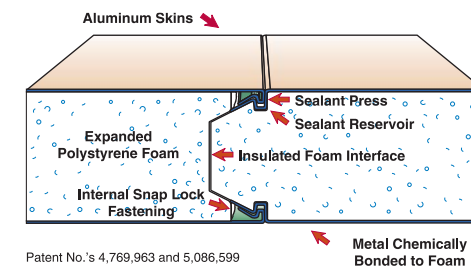
Below: Beams help support wider spans for larger pool enclosure.

Variety of Design.

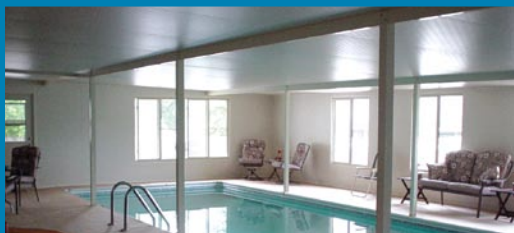
